We would like to thank you for your continued support in raising the standards this academic year. Our Believe Belong Become values (BBB values), introduced last year, are beginning to make a notable impact on personal and academic standards and will continue to be strengthened over the coming months following consultation with staff and students. The introduction of an enhanced behaviour protocol from Monday 6th March, linked to our BBB values, will lead to the values-based learning environment we strive for, where everyone can feel safe and happy to learn and work.

Belong

Become

I will make responsible decisions and influence others for the benefit of everyone (acting for the greater good).

Importantly, both students and staff have worked on various aspects of the enhanced protocol which includes improving our Academy Standards:

- Uniform and appearance code
- Code of Conduct
- Consistency Across the Classroom
- In the Academy 'I will statements'

Although there are only a few minor changes in the Academy standards, the consultation with students and staff was an important one and has allowed us to improve our rewards and consequence system. The impact of this is that students will feel more valued if they model the

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BBB values, gaining personally and academically. Consequently, over time, less students will disrupt their own and other's learning.

Can I ask you to familiarise yourself with the BBB values and our Academy Standards which are located on our website www.UCEAcademy.org under the 'Parents' section. Please discuss them with your child and reinforce how to model these on a minute by minute basis in school.
