The days have been selected so that options do not clash with one another allowing students to maximise their learning opportunities. Students will receive a personalised timetable indicating what subject and evening they will attend on return after half term.

In past years, P6 has been an extremely effective way of improving grades before the exam season starts. It is vital that your child attends all sessions available to them. During P6 registers will be taken daily. Students who regularly attend P6 will receive the chance of a free prom ticket. If a student refuses to turn up to P6, parents will be informed. If a student regularly fails to attend P6, a parental meeting will be requested and a student consequence will be put into place, this could include the removal of the privilege of attending the Year 11 prom 2019.

Mock examinations for all Year 11 Students – Start 13th November

The Academy has organised mock examinations for all Year 11 students, these will begin on the 13th November. The outline of this schedule is provided in the mock examination timetable attached to this letter. It is essential that you support your child in revising at home over the half term period. Structured revision sessions will take place in lessons and period 6 after half term.
